(prayer shawl)

What /

Jewish prayer shawl worn during prayers/ a special occassion. It has special twined and knotted fringes known as tzitzit attached to it's four corners. This literally means cloak or sheet. It has remained an inseparable part of Jewish worship.







Design /

The lines of the tallit is something that Jews can easily identify with and relate to. They can be graphically intepreted into line dividers/ borders/ decorative elements etc and would reiforce the prayer aspect of the event, conveying our support for Israel.

TZITZIT

(tassels)

What /

These are knotted fringes tied at the four corners of the tallit. They must be made with intent, with specific number of threads that winds around and hangs losely at the end. The number of winds adds up to represent the direct speilling of God's name. The total number of threads adds up to the Jewish laws.





Design /

The intricacy of how the tzitzit threads intertwines is a beautiful and meaningful symbolism of the rich jewish culture and it's significance today. Many jews still attach tzitzits on their clothings as a reminder of their Jewish laws and traditions. This would be an ideal visual to celebrate their traditions and culture.







Why blue /

This blue dye is mentioned 49 times in the Tanakh. It was used for the tzitzit connected to the corners of the tallit. This exclusive dye was produced from a marine creature, hillazon. This color reminded the Jews about their connection to royalty and the residence of God; in the heavenlies. It is also close to Israel's flag colour.

Research — Tzedakah box





Tzedakah box /

A traditionally humble container that is usually found in synagogues/ jewish homes and institutions where charitable donations are deposited. It acts as a physical reminder to give those in need regardless of your means. The hebrew word 'tzedakah' is literally translated into the word 'righteousness' and it comes in various form, shape, material and size. It usually has a small slit at the top for the charitable donations to be slipped in.
